### **SCS Honors Three Distinguished Scientists**

The SCS Award Committee has elected **Ben L. Feringa** from the University of Groningen (Netherlands) as the Paracelsus Prize winner 2008 for lifetime achievements in chemical research. The prize includes 20,000 Swiss francs and a gold medal. It will be awarded during the SCS Fall Meeting 2008. Furthermore, **Jeroen A. van Bokhoven** from ETH Zurich will receive the SCS Werner Prize, and **Alexander Heckel** from the University of Bonn (Germany) has been awarded the SCS Grammaticakis-Neumann Prize.

### **Swiss and Hungarian Chemical Societies to Establish Lectureship Exchange Program**

The Swiss Chemical Society and the Hungarian Chemical Society (HCS) have signed an invitational lectureship agreement. Under this agreement, each Society will select a scientist residing in the country of the other Society to give lectures. Each Society will invite a lecturer every two years in turn.
